


UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION

Applications:

- 1- May be filled out on-line on https://sis.ndu.edu.lb/iApply
- 2- Submitted by hard copy to the Office of Admissions with a fee of L.L. 100,000 (USD 67)

NDU Entrance Exam fees are L.L. 150,000 (USD 100); L.L. 75,000 (USD 50) (English); L.L. 75,000 (USD 50) (Aptitude)]. All fees are non-refundable.

The following documents must be submitted with each application form:

- A Secondary School Record for the last three academic years (Grades 10, 11 and 12);
- A Letter of Recommendation from the Principal;
- A photocopy of the National Identity Card or Passport;
- Two recent passport-size photos; and
- A certified copy of Lebanese Baccalaureate Part II or its equivalence.

Applicants must either sit for the NDU Entrance Exams or submit scores of external exams (TOEFL, SAT I, and IELTS).

Freshman applicants must additionally submit:

- o An official school document attesting that they have completed and passed their High School requirements or High School Diploma;
- o A certified copy of the written authorization from the Equivalence Committee; and
- o Scores of SAT I (upon submission of the application), and SAT II (once available. Note: SAT II scores should be submitted before the end of the second Freshman semester).

Applicants must submit original or certified copies of all the required documents. All submitted documents, whether the applicant has been accepted or not, become the property of NDU.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must satisfy an acknowledged level of English proficiency to be admitted.

NDU recognizes one of the following instruments to measure this level:

- EET (English Entrance Test) administered by NDU or
- TOEFL (Test of English as Foreign Language) or
- Reading & Writing Section of Redesigned SAT I or
- IELTS (International English Language Testing System).

Applicants may retrieve their Letter of Admission along with the registration process guideline on-line from the university website, or collect them from the Office of Admissions. In case of missing documents, applicants are encouraged to pass by the Office of Admissions Counter for further assistance.

FRESHMAN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students holding the written Authorization from the Equivalence Committee of the Lebanese Ministry of Education and Higher Education (MEHE) to pursue their higher education on the basis of a Foreign Program may apply to the Freshman Class. They must hold a secondary school certificate (High School Diploma) recognized by the MEHE. Applicants to the Freshman Class are required to take the Scholastic Aptitude Test SAT I prior to registration as required by the Lebanese Ministry of Education for the equivalence of the Lebanese Baccalaureate Part II. SAT II tests, which correspond to the Freshman Sciences or Arts streams, should be taken during the Freshman year. SAT I includes Evidence-Based Reading/Writing and Math. SAT II (Arts) includes Math 1C plus two SAT II Subjects Tests. SAT II (Sciences) includes Math 2C plus two of the following science subjects (Biology, Chemistry, Physics). The required minimum score for the combined SAT I and SAT II is 2600 for Freshman Arts and 2750 for Freshman Sciences (old SAT I + SAT II) whereas 2150 for Freshman Arts and 2300 for Freshman Sciences (redesigned SAT I + SAT II).

Note: Freshman students must successfully complete at least 30 credits in order to receive an equivalence. Students may not be promoted to a Sophomore (or any other) class before they complete all Freshman requirements.

SOPHOMORE AND FIRST YEAR ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for the Sophomore or First Year Class, applicants must hold the Lebanese Baccalaureate Part II or its equivalent, as determined by the Lebanese Ministry of Education. The strand of the Lebanese Baccalaureate Part II (General Sciences, Literature and Humanities, Social Sciences and Economics, Life Sciences) must correspond to the requirements of the desired program of study of the respective Faculties at NDU. Applicants must accumulate a certain composite score (CS) required by these Faculties to be admitted in their respective majors. This score is calculated by allocating 55% weight to the last 2 years' school averages and 45% to NDU Math Aptitude Test or Math for SAT I.


