## Biography

Danielle Zaccour joined NDU on October 2001, and currently holds the rank of Assistant Professor.

Ms. Zaccour holds a DES degree in “Plastic Arts” from the Academie Libanaise des Beaux Arts (ALBA) in 1991, where she started her teaching career. Her main academic teaching focus at NDU bore quite exclusively on fundamental art cognitive elements as essential instruments in the formation of FAAD students regardless of their specific academic orientations.

In 2010, she was appointed as the coordinator of the Art Department till date. In her many years at NDU, Ms. Zaccour has taught all art courses offered in the faculty. Moreover, she has developed/ co-developed all art syllabi in the last 14 years. She has been instrumental in upgrading academic programs relevant to the Art Department.
