Biography

Dr. Farid Younes earned his Diplome d'étude superieur (D.E.S) in Architecture at I.N.B.A. (Institut National des Beaux-Arts), Lebanon, in 1987. He pursued graduate studies in Environmental Design (Aménagement) in University of Montreal, Canada, and earned his Master Degree (M.Sc. A.) and his Ph.D. in 1997. In 1996, he taught at USEK (Université Saint Esprit, Kaslik) and BAU (Beirut Arab University) as a part time instructor in the Graduate and Undergraduate Programs. After being the Chairperson of the Architecture Department at Notre Dame University, Lebanon, from 1999 to 2005, currently, he is an Associate Professor since 2006. He is currently writing two books, the first entitled: The Fallacy of Architectural Discourse: an Idealistic Nihilism!, in an attempt to expose the major schools of thought in architecture in relation to their inspiring philosophical ones and the second book, almost finished, entitled: Farid Younes by Friedrich Nietzsche, in an attempt to either contradict his thought or being more cynical and adding new dimensions to his.
