Biography

Habib H. Melki completed his undergraduate studies in the United States before earning a Master of Architecture in Historic Preservation from Ball State University in June 1985, Muncie, Indiana, USA. He joined Notre Dame University-Louaize (NDU) initially as a part-time faculty member in 1988 and was appointed as a full-time faculty member in 1992. Dr. Melki has held various leadership roles at NDU, including Chairman of the Visual Art Department in the Faculty of Humanities (FH) from 1999 to 2000 and Chairman of the Design Department in the Faculty of Architecture, Art, and Design (FAAD) from 2000 to 2004. Dr. Melki is an Associate Member of PLEA International (Passive Low Energy Architecture). He was honored to serve as Chairman of the PLEA 22nd International Conference in 2005, hosted and organized by NDU in collaboration with PLEA International. He has also contributed as a member of the Technical Committee for PLEA conferences in 2007, 2008, and 2012. In September 2014, Dr. Melki completed his Ph.D. in History of Art at the Faculty of History, University of the Holy Spirit-Kaslik (USEK). His doctoral research focused on the "Development of 'Openings' and their Ornamentation in Relation to the Environmental Aspects of Lebanese Traditional Architecture Between the 18th and 20th Centuries." Throughout his time at NDU, Dr. Melki has been actively involved in organizing a series of local, regional, and international student workshops, conducted in countries including Switzerland, France, Spain, Morocco, Belgium, Oman, Italy, Greece, Turkey, and Dubai. From October 2014 to August 2016, Dr. Melki served as the Chairperson of the Architecture Department, and from October 2019 to August 2022, he held the position of Dean of the Faculty of Architecture, Art, and Design (RC-FAAD). He has held the rank of Associate Professor since 2012.
