# Exercises for Writing the Reference List of a Research Paper

## (Following APA Guidelines)

**Objective:** The following exercise will help students write their sources in a well-organized reference list by following APA guidelines.

#### **Directions:**

First, use the information given under each source to write an entry for your reference list.

Second, combine all sources in your reference list in ALPHABETICAL order according to the author's LAST name.

#### Source 1: Book

Author, A. A. (Year of publication). *Title of work: Capital letter also for subtitle*. Location:

Publisher.

## **Source 2: Edited Book (with author)**

<u>NOTE</u>: Same format applied to books, but add (**Eds.**) after author's name if the book has two or more editors, and (**Ed.**) if the book has one editor. Add **edition** after title of the book **IF** there is more than one edition.

## Source 3: Article or Chapter from an Edited Book

Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (Year of publication). Title of chapter. In A. Editor & B.

Editor (Eds.), *Title of book* (pages of chapter pp.). Location: Publisher.
