



Abstract Submission Guidelines

The Scientific Committee of CS³ invites authors to submit abstracts for consideration within the program either as research papers to be presented, or posters to be exhibited during the exhibition. Please read the abstract requirements carefully prior to submitting your abstracts. Abstracts not fulfilling the requirements will not be considered for review. The following guidelines should be used by authors:

- Abstract must be written in English, and presented in English at the conference.
- Abstracts must present original work that has not been previously presented at conferences or in journals elsewhere.
- Abstracts should be submitted via the CS³ <u>ONLINE SUBMISSION SYSTEM</u> for consideration as a presented paper or a poster.
- Abstract should have a clear title and include three keywords, and three references.
- Abstracts should not exceed 300 words.
- Authors should include their names, affiliations, contact details, and a short biography not exceeding 100 words for each of the abstract authors.
- Authors should clearly indicate the first and second choice of tracks for their respective submissions. See conference <u>TRACKS</u>.
- Authors of accepted abstracts are requested to present their papers during the conference in one of the track sessions. At least one of the authors should be present at the conference.
- After notification of abstract acceptance for presentation in the conference, at least one of the abstract authors should register within 10 working days from the date of the notification letter, which is within the early bird registration period.
- Information on paper presentations or poster exhibition will be given to authors in due course.

The call for abstracts will be opened starting 4 September 2017. The deadline for submitting abstracts is 18 December 2017.

Authors will receive notification on their abstracts on 12 February 2018. Authors of accepted abstracts will submit their papers by 14 May 2017. Authors wishing to have their papers considered for publication in the proceedings will have to respond to comments and resubmit their papers by 2 July 2018. Notification of the winner of the Best Paper Award prize will take place during the conference.

<u>Submission of an abstract is preceded by completing your registration form. Paying the fees could be completed at a later stage.</u>
