

Poster Submission Guidelines

Posters accepted for the conference shall be exhibited in a designated exhibition space for open poster viewing. The authors of accepted posters shall be invited for a scheduled Poster Session oral presentation.

Whether a medium for interaction between a presenter and audience, or conveying information for visitors on behalf of the author, all posters should facilitate a clear transfer of research information through adhering to the following poster submission requirements in addition to the general submission guidelines:

- Posters should have a title, an abstract of 250 words, three keywords, introduction, methodology, figures/tables/images, results, conclusion, and references.
- Posters should communicate information clearly by providing legible, appropriately sized, arranged, numbered and captioned visuals.
- The posters will be presented within the CS² exhibition in designated spaces and on designated panels. The posters should be mounted by their authors at the latest on the morning of the first conference day.
- Poster Size: A1 DIN in Portrait layout.
- Title: Upper case, Arial bold 75 points.
- Subtitle: Upper case, Arial regular 60 points.
- Body text: Sentence case, Arial regular 25/30 points.
- Footnotes and captions: sentence case, Arial regular 18 points.
- Margins: 5 cm (top, bottom, left and right).
- Resolution of images on the poster: 300dpi.
- All content should be the author's including text, and graphics.
- The A1 poster should be printed as a minimum of 3508x4967 pixels.
- Authors of posters must register and be present at the conference.
- Each author can present only one poster.
