

SCHOLARSHIPS, ACADEMIC & EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

Student Programs

1. <u>Global Undergraduate Exchange Program:</u>

Program is open for high school (Grade 12/Terminale/3rd year of Leb. Baccalaureate) and first, second and third year university students. Students will spend 2 academic semesters in the U.S. taking ugrad courses (from their major or any other major) while engaging in campus activities, community service (first semester) and internship (second semester).

- App. Dates: Program will open in December 2013 and deadline to receive apps will be early Feb 2014.
- **Travel dates:** summer 2014 (late July 2014)
- **Benefits:** Insurance, roundtrip ticket, stipend (to cover basic needs), lodging (on campus), meal plan, books, and other allowances.

2. <u>MEPI-Student Leaders Program:</u>

Provides the opportunity to Lebanese ugrad students (18-24 years) to visit the U.S. to attend leadership training workshops, academic sessions and learn about the United States' history and culture.

- App. Dates: Program will open in December 2013 and deadline to receive apps will be end of Jan/early Feb 2014.
- **Travel dates:** summer 2014 (late June 2014)
- **Benefits:** Insurance, roundtrip ticket, stipend (to cover basic needs), lodging (on campus/and a weekend at host family), meals, and other allowances.

3. <u>Fulbright Foreign Student Scholarship Program</u>

Provides students the opportunity to obtain a master's degree in a wide range of academic fields at a university in the United States. Grants are for students to pursue graduate/Master's studies for up to 2 years (one-year programs are certainly accepted.) Eligible students are those who already hold a minimum of a bachelor degree or will complete their ugrad and obtain their BAs by no later than June 2015.

- **App. Dates**: Program will open in early February 2014 and deadline to receive apps will be in mid May 2014.
- Travel dates: summer 2015 (late July/early August 2015) depends on the university in the U.S.
- **Benefits:** Roundtrip airfare, tuition, books, health insurance, stipend (to cover living and lodging), other allowances.
