#### **Unsigned Encyclopedia Article**

Tidal wave. (1982). *In The New Encyclopaedia Americana*. (vol.28, pp. 213-216). New York: Americana.

#### **Monthly Periodical**

Davison, P. (2000, May). Girl, seeming to disappear. *Atlantic Monthly*, 108-111.

#### **Signed Article in Weekly Periodical**

Gladwell, M. (2000, May 29). The new-boy network. *The New Yorker*, 68-86.

#### **Unsigned Article in Weekly Periodical**
