NDU is committed to providing you with an exceptional education at exceptional value, with a variety of financial aid, scholarships, and grants for which you might be eligible.

NDU offers three forms of financial aid to new students: Financial Aid Upon Admission, Sibling Grant, and Scholarships Upon Admission. In case of being eligible for multiple scholarships/forms of financial aid, the highest percentage is always chosen.

## Scholarships upon admission:

- Scored well on your SAT I or Lebanese/French Baccalaureate?
- Any scholarship upon admission you are entitled to will be automatically given once you are accepted.

## Applying for the Sibling Grant:

- Access Financial Aid on the SIS, click on Sibling Grant and add your sibling's ID number
- Submit a copy of the Family Status Record (not older than one year) to the Department of Financial Aid

## Applying for Financial Aid upon Admission:

Think you'll need Financial Aid upon Admission? Complete the following steps before the deadlines for submission: **end of June for the Fall Semester**, and **end of November for Spring**.

Fill out the Financial Aid application online with one of your parents.

Make sure all sections are completed in their entirety

Schedule an appointment online for an interview with the Department of Financial Aid

At least one of your parents must come with you

The interview can take up to one hour

Print the application and have you and your parent sign all the required documents

Submit the application with all required documents in person during the interview scheduled with the staff in the Department of Financial Aid

The sooner you complete these, the sooner we can process your application and provide you with the help you need. A delay in the application may negatively impact the amount and nature of the aid we can provide.

# BEGIN YOUR JOURNEY

1. Complete your online application and payment at <https://sis.ndu.edu.lb/iApply/> or Submit a hard copy to the Office of Admissions with a fee of LBP 100,000 (USD 67).
2. The documents to be provided are:
  - a. Secondary School Results for the last three academic years (S1, S2 and S3 or Grade 10, 11, and 12)
  - b. A photocopy of your National Identity Card or Passport
  - c. Two recent, passport-sized photos
  - d. A certified copy of the Lebanese Baccalaureate II or its equivalent
3. Sit for the NDU Entrance Exams or submit scores of the following exams:
  - a. Redesigned SAT I Writing and Language, or TOEFL, or IELTS
  - b. SAT I Math

- NDU Entrance Exam fees are LBP 75,000 (USD 50) (English); LBP 75,000 (USD 50) (Aptitude). All fees are non-refundable.

- All documents submitted must be original certified copies, and, once submitted, become the property of NDU regardless of whether applicants are accepted.

## English Proficiency Requirements

All applicants must satisfy an acknowledged level of English proficiency to be admitted. NDU recognizes one of the following tests to measure this level:

- EET (English Entrance Test) administered by NDU or
- TOEFL (Test of English as Foreign Language) or
- Redesigned SAT I Writing and Language section or
- IELTS (International English Language Testing System).

Students are advised to take/repeat any of the above English Proficiency Tests for a chance to improve the score and hence, reduce the number of the English remedial courses.

## IF YOU ARE

### A FRESHMAN STUDENT

1 An official school attestation stating that you have completed and passed your High School requirements or High School Diploma

2 Written Authorization from the MEHE – Equivalence Committee to your higher education on the basis of a foreign Program

3 Scores of your SAT I (upon submission of the application), and

4 SAT II scores once available, to be submitted before the end of your second Freshman semester (Note: The minimum required combined score for the SAT I and SAT II is 2150 for Freshman Arts and 2300 for Freshman Sciences)

5 30 credits need to be completed at the freshman level

**Note:** If you are a Freshman Science student, you can declare any major of your choice. If you are a Freshman Arts student, you can declare any major except for Engineering and Computer Science.

SAT I includes Evidence-Based Reading/Writing and Math. SAT II (Arts) includes Math 1C plus two SAT II Subjects Tests. SAT II (Sciences) includes Math 2C plus two of the following science subjects (Biology, Chemistry, Physics)

1 An official transcript of the undergraduate record

2 A copy of the undergraduate courses description certified by the university

**Note:** If you are coming from an international university/college, you need to certify the official transcript at the Embassy of the relevant country in Lebanon and at the Lebanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
