- Be looking to pursue a Master’s degree in Actuarial Sciences at NDU or be currently enrolled in the program.
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.6/4.0 on their undergraduate studies
- Have exemplary academic and personal track record during their undergraduate studies
- Be willing to support Chedid Re in any tactical support through their graduate studies and beyond
- Integrate the human capital of Chedid Re throughout their graduate studies and – upon job vacancy availability – after graduation.
- Be willing to sign an undertaking letter in which they pledge to reimburse the full fees paid on their behalf by the scholarship in the event they decide to drop the program for any reason
- Be available for an interview
- Complete all requirements and graduate in two years

The Scholarship will remain in effect as long as the student remains in good academic standing.
