

An internal garden is designed around and within the building, allowing nature to organically intertwine with the structure, creating a captivating interplay between the man-made and the natural. Additionally, the project utilizes an existing excavation on the site, designing the new elements in a sunken way to avoid overwhelming the historic building. This approach ensures that the focus remains on the traditional house while seamlessly integrating the new design. The design integrates with the natural topography, minimizing disruption and maximizing the immersive experience of nature. The buildings will be built on multiple levels, following the natural slope of the land. This reduces visual impact and allows for green roofs and terraces that blend with the surrounding tree line. Strategically placed skylights and clerestories will bring natural light deep into the buildings, reducing reliance on artificial lighting and creating a sense of openness. Winding pathways made of natural materials like gravel or wood chips will meander through the resort, connecting buildings and treatment areas. 

This is particularly significant given the high levels of pollution in the area caused by illegal sand crushers that are working all around the project . The design incorporates a blend of precast concrete and traditional materials, alongside steel for the monitoring tower. The third floor, which serves as the entry and exit point for delivery drones, uses traditional concrete, while the structural core of the steel tower adds to the complexity. These elements collectively present a unique and challenging design scenario.


Tabbaneh Vocational School

The project is on a triangular lot on the western bank of the Abu Ali River in Tripoli, North Lebanon. Surrounded by mid-level and poor communities, the plot was left intact for several years despite its potential to be a node that connects the western bank (mid-level community) and eastern bank (poor community). The mixed-use area shows a diversity of residential, commercial, small industries, amenities, and religious buildings – with no educational presence. Moreover, Al Tabbaneh is rich and diverse in the urban and architectural features that reflect social, economic, and psychological deteriorations that occurred through time.

Standing strong as an architectural intervention for the oppressed citizens of Tripoli - North Lebanon, Tabbaneh Vocational School is intended to be the social, educational, and urban node of the city.

Urbanely, transforming the Abu Ali River, the edge into a pedestrian link between the two banks will make the area united. This will be achieved through the site suppression towards the river.

On the educational level, this vocation is the first in the area to introduce a flexible curriculum that changes according to needs, alongside an exhibition area and an auditorium.

All this is reflected in a socially-driven architectural concept inspired by the corridor effect and clustering of Bab El Tabbaneh Suburb: The theoretical framework that led to the stacked blocks going down towards the river.














The wellness center is designed to foster a calming environment that reduces stress and promotes well-being. Inspired by the fluidity of natural landscapes, the design employs curved and fluid shapes that mimic the organic forms of nature. This approach ensures access to serene views of both the river and the sea, leading to the use of double glass facades throughout. The center focuses on three hydrotherapy experiences: transitioning between sweet and salt water, alternating between hot and cold water, and balancing introverted and extroverted therapies. These experiences are enhanced by integrating the facility into the natural topography, creating spaces that connect deeply with the earth while offering expansive views of the sea. Additionally, the use of rotated vertical louvers on the double glass facade provides necessary shading towards the west and further integrates the building with its natural surroundings. The entire project is grounded in a detailed site analysis and thoughtful design process, ensuring that every element contributes to the overall sense of tranquility and rejuvenation.







The Silk Factory


My project is located in Maaser Beitdine, it's an abundant silk factory in Maaser Beit dine located near Ayoub station. It was built in 1893 and consisted was used as a warehouse and reeling area. During the 1990s, after the introduction of concrete second ¬floor was added to the adjacent section. Regarding the support structure, the traditional with concrete pillars to support the first-fl-oor level, which was also replaced with a concrete structure. During the 1830-1930 Golden Age of Silk, the Khattar family's Silk Mill in Maasser Beit ed-Dine, built in 1893, prospered. Initially tending to poultry and transitioned to caring for silkworms fed on local environments, they sold cocoons to the Maasser Beit ed-Dine factory for silk thread extraction. This Lebanese silk was mainly exported to France, occasionally role in the global silk trade.

Schools and universities can subscribe to the center, providing their students with scheduled access to XR experiences. 





Nexus



CONCEPT

The concept is a structure stimulated by the cosmic web; a vast structure of the universe which bears a striking resemblance to brain neurons with its intricate network-like appearance, which is seen in my project through the different shapes found in each level and how they overlap creating dynamism. Moreover, the shapes revolve around circular element which symbolize the planets and their movement in space. Additionally, a sphere which functions as a planetarium symbolizes the Sun, with a circular bridge encircling it to emulate planetary orbits, echoing the vibrations of celestial bodies in motion. Projections from the centers of the circles symbolize the disparity between Earth time and Space time. Furthermore, the project's different levels as well as the cylindrical elements that go through all the floors evoke the sensation of weightlessness in space due to the absence of gravity.
