Geha has a BA in English Literature, a Teaching Diploma, and an MA in Education (TEFL) from the American University of Beirut. She taught communication skills courses at the Lebanese American University and tutored at the university's writing center for 5 years. Natalia completed the Fulbright Junior Faculty Development program in TEFL at North Carolina State University in the summer of 2017. She started teaching at NDU in 2009 as a part-time instructor in both the English and Education departments, then as a full-time lecturer, starting Fall 2017; duties and responsibilities included coordinating courses and redesigning syllabi using open educational resources. During those years, Natalia also founded and organized NDU's first TEDx event (TEDxNDULouaize) for 5 years and became a trainer for NDU students taking part in the Young Arab Voices National Debate Competition.
