

Abstract Submission Guidelines

The Scientific Committee of CS² invites authors to submit abstracts for consideration within the program either as research papers to be presented, or posters to be exhibited during the exhibition. Please read the abstract requirements carefully prior to submitting your abstracts. Abstracts not fulfilling the requirements will not be considered for review. The following guidelines should be used by authors:

- Abstract must be written in English, and presented in English at the conference.
- Abstracts must present original work that has not been previously presented at conferences or in journals elsewhere.
- Abstracts should be submitted via the CS² ONLINE SUBMISSION SYSTEM for consideration as a presented paper or a poster.
- Abstract should have a clear title and include three keywords, and three references.
- Abstracts should not exceed 300 words.
- Authors should include their names, affiliations, contact details, and a short biography not exceeding 100 words for each of the abstract authors.
- Authors should clearly indicate the first and second choice of tracks for their respective submissions. See conference TRACKS.
- Authors of accepted abstracts are requested to present their papers during the conference in one of the track sessions. At least one of the authors should be present at the conference.
- After notification of abstract acceptance for presentation in the conference, at least one of the abstract authors should register within 10 working days from the date of the notification letter, which is within the early bird registration period.
- Information on paper presentations or poster exhibition will be given to authors in due course.

The call for abstracts will be opened starting 1 September 2015. The deadline for submitting abstracts is 4 December 2015.

Authors will receive notification on their abstracts on 5 February 2016. Authors of accepted abstracts will submit their papers on 9 May 2016. Authors wishing to have their papers considered for publication in a special issue will have to respond to comments sent 11 July 2016, and resubmit their papers on 1 August 2016.

Submission of an abstract is preceded by completing your registration form. Paying the fees could be completed at a later stage.
